

HOW ARE IB STUDENTS ASSESSED IN THE IBDP PROGRAMME?

There are two kinds of IB assessments:
External and Internal

EXTERNAL ASSESSMENTS (WRITTEN EXAMS)

given at the end of the Year 2 (grade 12) and this includes

- Structured problems
- Short-response questions
- Data-response questions
- Text-response questions
- Case-study questions
- Multiple-choice questions (Physics, Chemistry, Biology)
- Extended essay, TOK essay
- Visual Arts Comparative study, Process portfolio
- HL Essay in English

INTERNAL ASSESSMENTS

includes

- Oral assessment in languages (English and Hindi)
- Investigations / Reports / Commentaries in all subjects
- Visual Art exhibition
- TOK Presentation

DO CBSE STUDENTS HAVE AN ADVANTAGE OVER IB STUDENTS IN COMPETITIVE EXAMS?

FOR AIEEE (JEE) IIT'S, NIT'S

- 1 Pass rate of top 6 IIT's is about 0.34% (4000 students cleared / 12 lakhs students who appeared)
- 2 Students mostly go for dummy / integrated school (board does not matter) so that they can give full attention to JEE coaching
- 3 Most successful students come from big coaching centers such as Kota, Hyderabad where they start as young as Grade 7
- 4 Intense preparation pressure on students through these years often leads to physiological & psychological stresses

SOME EYE OPENING POINTS FROM THE RESEARCH REPORT SUBMITTED BY TATA INSTITUTE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES (TISS) TO KOTA DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

- Kota reported 58 student suicides (2013-2017) excluding attempted suicides.
- Kota ranked highest in the number of suicides linked to failure in exams between 2011-2014 (among 88 Indian cities considered for the study)
- Kota is a teeming 'Prep factory' – every year around 2 lakh students from across the country go to Kota for JEE or NEET preparation
- For engineering students
 - 49% feel nervous, worried and scared
 - 42% respondents said that their friends were worried, nervous or scared
 - 37% students reported being irritable and getting annoyed easily
 - 32% admitted to feeling upset or sad for the most part of the day or for days at a time
 - For Pre-Med Students - 28% students reported feelings of hopelessness and helplessness, 28% students felt worthless and 27% students were worried about failure and 'letting their families down'

- 5 The study reported a large occurrence of sleep-related disorders where students reported feeling constantly tired, feeling sleepy or sleep deprived, facing problems falling asleep or staying awake
- 6 Students also reported indigestion, loss of appetite as well as obesity
- 7 One third of the female students reported menstrual disorders

CONCLUSION : The board doesn't matter. Coaching matters for JEE preparation, which has its own pitfalls

FOR PRIVATE COLLEGES ENGINEERING EXAMS/ MEDICAL/ COMMERCE/ARTS/HUMANITIES

- 1 BITSAT
 - 10+2 from any recognised board (including IB) with PCM/B with 75%
- 2 SRMJEE, VITEEE (ENGINEERING EXAMS)
 - IB students with PCM/B with 60%
- 3 NEET (MEDICAL EXAM)
 - This being a national exam, students from any board are allowed.
- 4 NATA (ARCHITECTURE EXAM)
 - IB and CBSE are in the same category
- 5 CLAT (LAW EXAM)
 - 10+2 from any recognised board (including IB) with 45%
 - Two top NLUs do not accept predicted grades but admission is possible in other NLU's
- 6 NID/NIFT/AIEED/SEAT ETC. (FOR DESIGN COURSES)
 - 10+2 from any recognised board (including IB)
- 7 NPAT, FEAT, SET, UGAT, IPMAT (MANAGEMENT EXAMS)
 - 10+2 from any recognised board (including IB)
- 8 Other state level exams

There might be specific quota for state board students

CONCLUSION :
In general,
IB students can appear
for all competitive exams.

DIPLOMA PROGRAMME - GRADE 11 AND GRADE 12

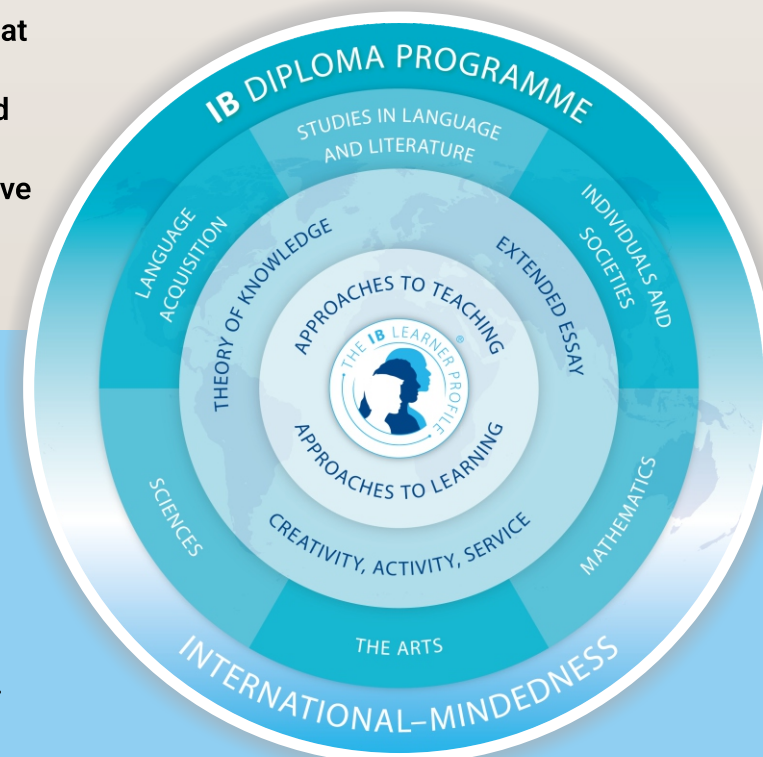

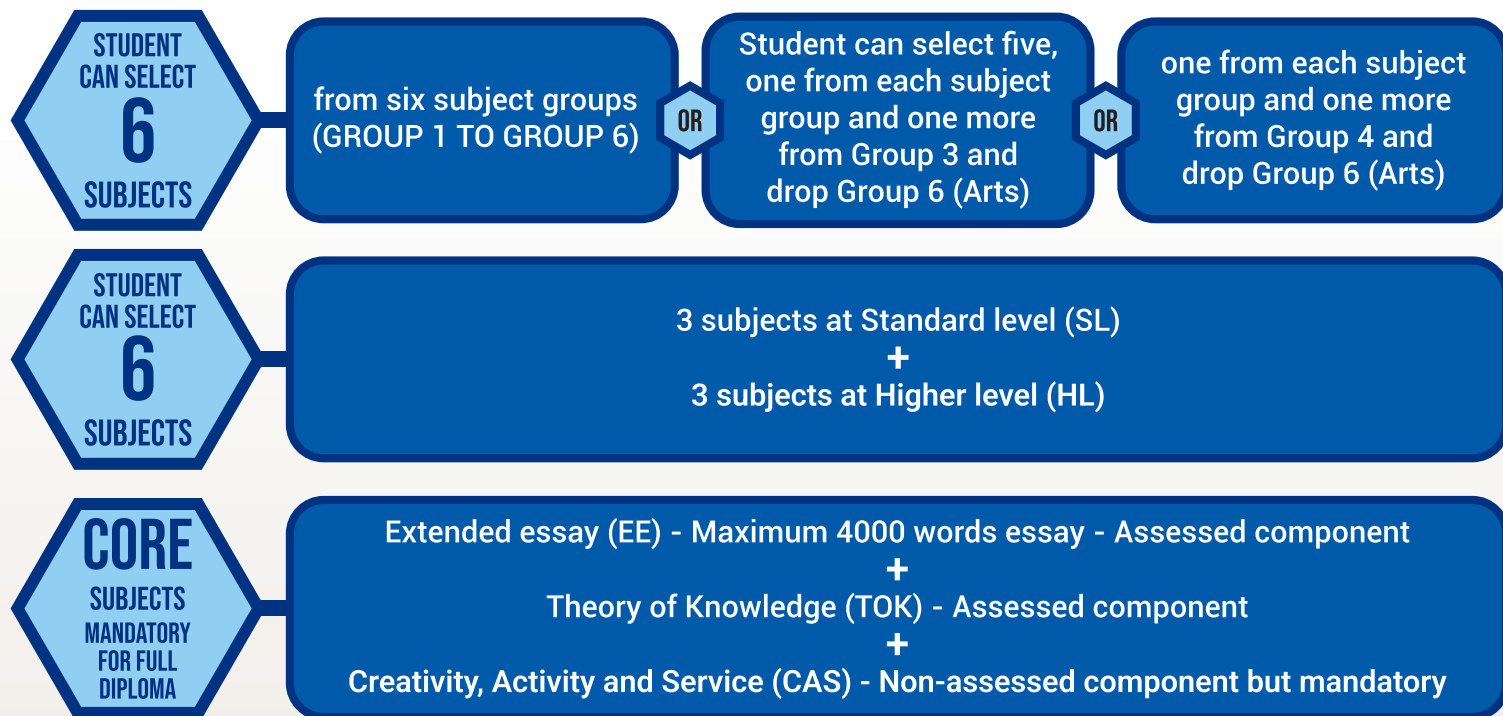
- İ DP core and six subject groups.

- Students may receive credits in a university as a result they may have to study less subjects in first year.
- It develops critical thinking, intercultural understanding and respect.
- Students may get scholarships.
- The IB programme correlates well with the university curriculum and program.
- All IB students outperform other students at the university.

IS THE DP EQUIVALENT TO 12TH IN INDIA?

YES,
the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme has been recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) as equivalent to Grade 12 (HSC) in India since 1983 and students are accepted in Indian Universities.

HOW DO STUDENTS ACHIEVE DIPLOMA CERTIFICATE?

- The maximum total score for Diploma certificate is 45.
- Each subject has achievement level 1 - 7 (7 being the highest).

No. of Subjects x Highest grade	Core (TOK and EE) (Based on a grid)	Total points
6 x 7 = 42 points	3 points	42 + 3 = 45 points

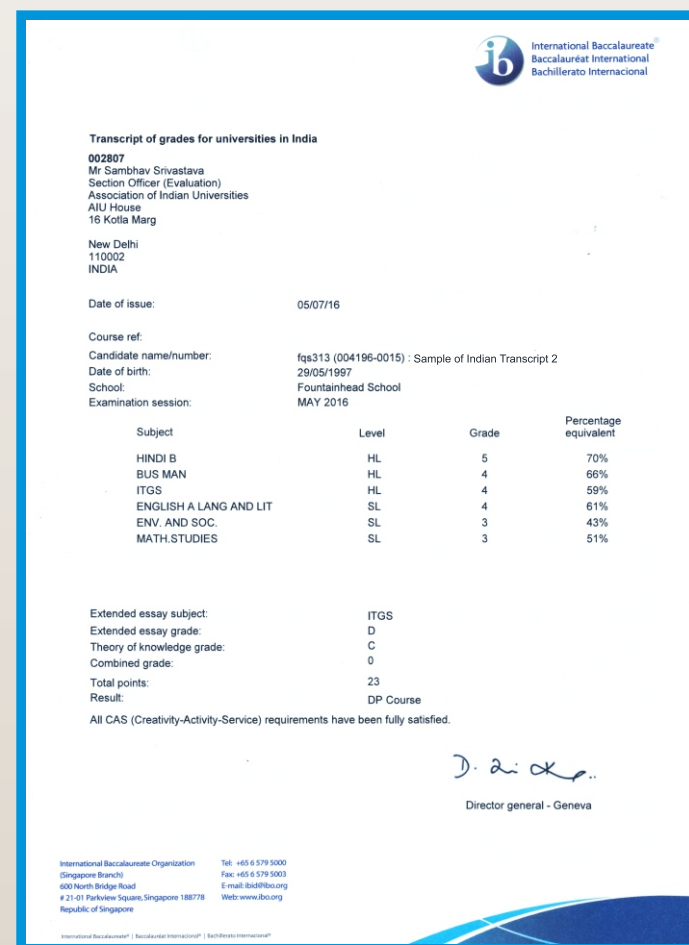
- Students must achieve a total of 24 points to get Diploma certificate. To add, there are total 9 conditions to be met for getting a Diploma certificate.
- Students seeking admission to Indian universities must follow the latest UGC equivalence guidelines and IB transcript submission procedures.
